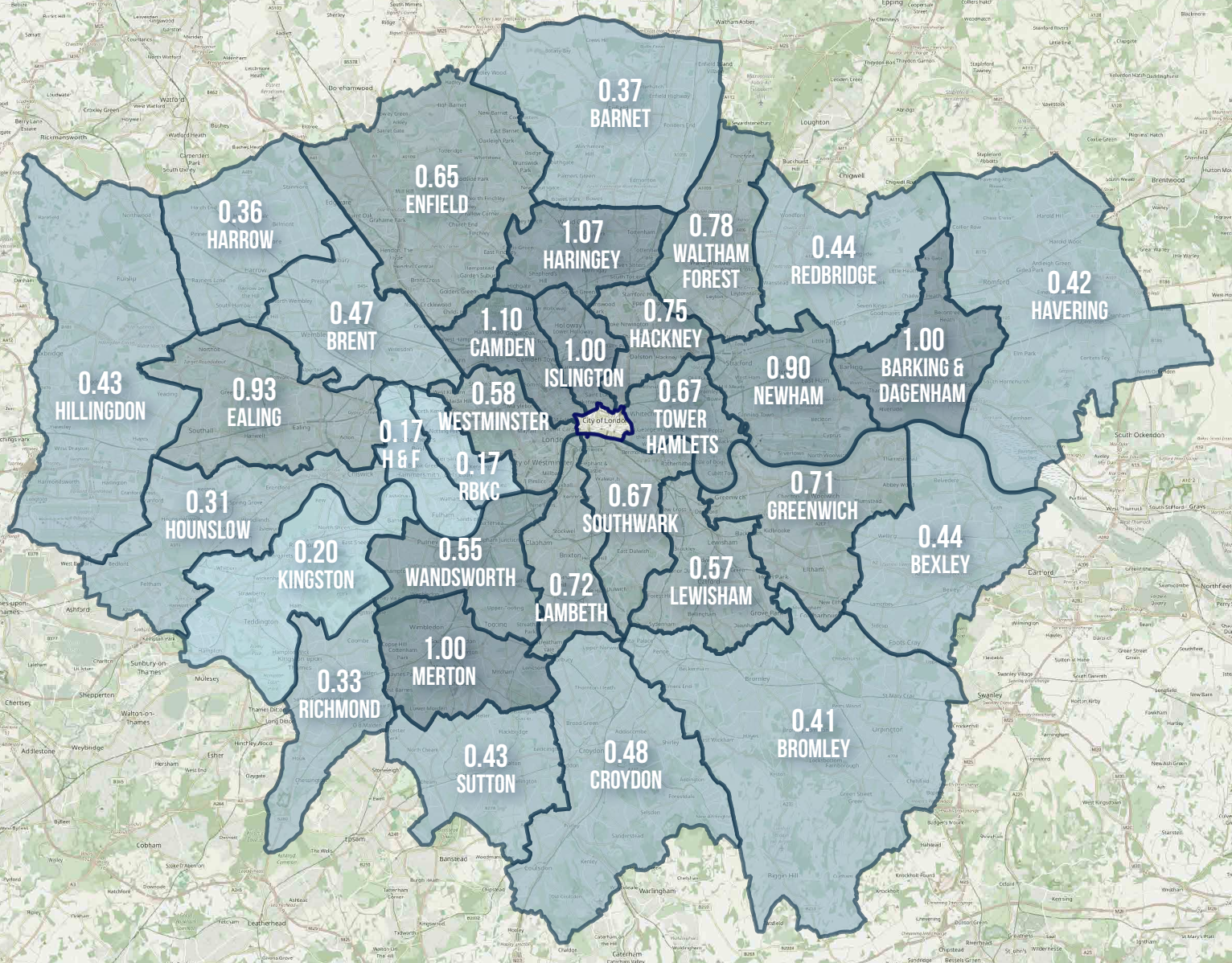


NUMBER OF POLICE SAFER SCHOOLS OFFICERS PER STATE SCHOOL IN EACH BOROUGH - 2016

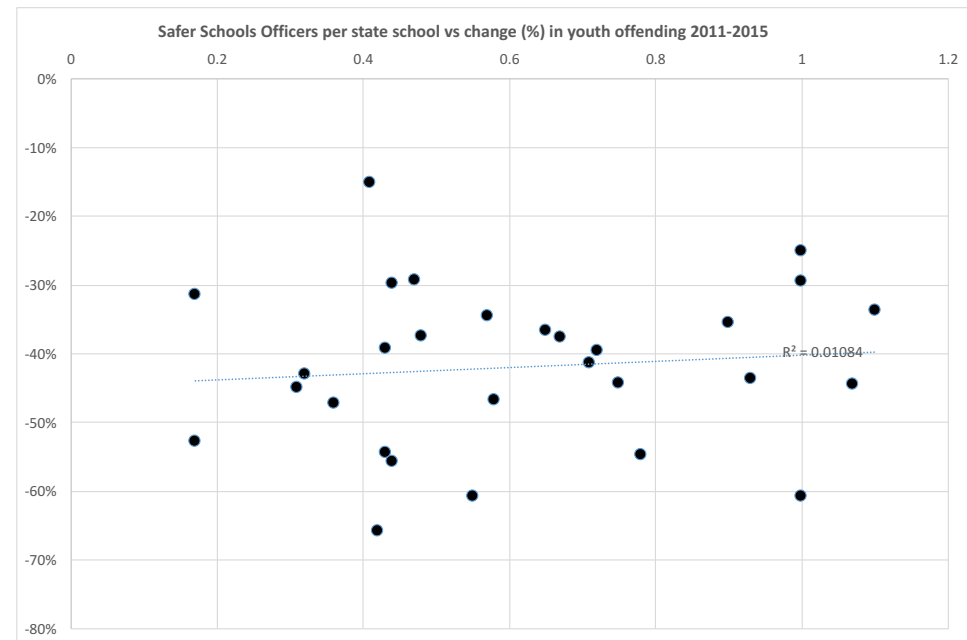
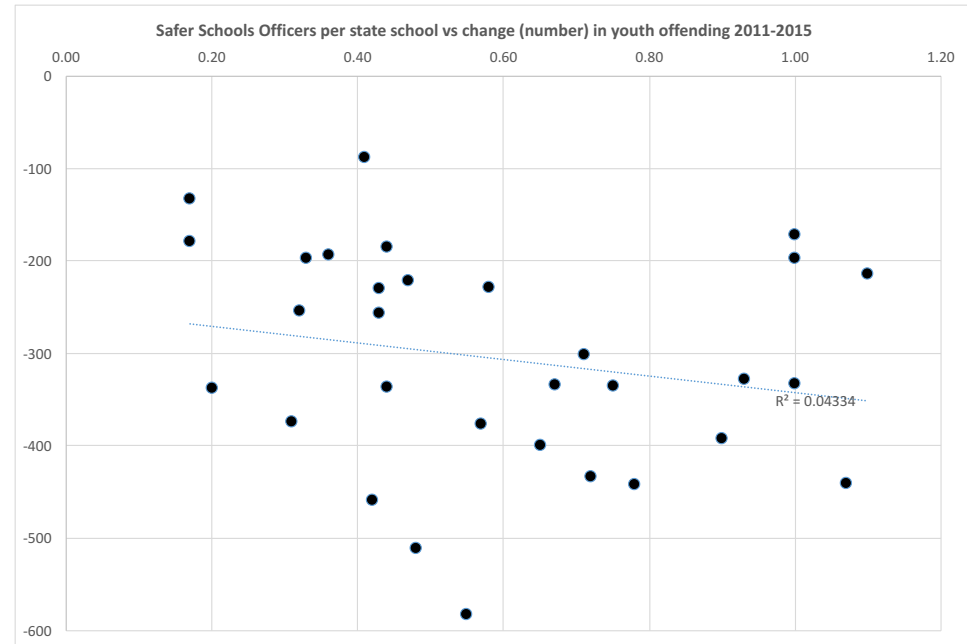


Safer Schools Officers and youth offending

Data shows youth offences declining across London, with this decline levelling off or increasing in the past two years in most boroughs.

There is no significant relationship between these trends and how many Safer Schools Officers are deployed in each borough.
